2) Submission of Tender:-

- a) Pre-qualification/Technical Bid and Financial Bid both will have to be submitted online concurrently duly digitally signed in the website <https://wbtenders.gov.in> as per time schedule stated herein under.
- b) The Financial Bid of the prospective tenderers will be opened only if the tenderer qualifies in the Technical Bid The decision of the Tender Inviting Authority will be final and binding to all concerned and no challenge against such decision will be entertained

Tenders will be opened by the **Superintending Engineer, Circle II, R&B Sector, KMDA** or his authorized representative in presence of tenderer or their authorized representatives who may like to be present.

4) Eligibility criteria for the bidders :-

A) *The bidders should have the credentials as detailed below:*

- i) The prospective bidders shall have satisfactorily completed as a prime agency during the last 5(five) years prior to the date of issue of this Notice at least one work of similar nature under the authority of State/Central Gov., State/Central Gov. undertaking /Statutory Bodies constituted under the statute of the Central / State Government and having a magnitude of 40% (Forty percent) of the Estimated amount put to tender, or
- ii) Intending tenderers /bidders should produce credentials of 2(two) similar nature of completed work, each of the minimum value of 30% of the estimated amount put to tender during 5(five) years prior to the date of issue of the tender notice, or
- iii) Intending tenderers / bidders should produce credentials of one single running work of similar nature which has been completed to the extent of 80% or more and value of executed part of which is not less than the desired value at (i) above.

In case of running works, only those tenderers /bidders who will submit the current certificate of satisfactory running work from the concerned Executive Engineer, or equivalent competent authority will be eligible for the tender. In the required certificate it should be clearly stated that the work is in progress satisfactorily and also that no penal action has been initiated against the executing agency, i.e. the tenderer/bidders.

B) *Other terms and condition of the credentials:*

- i) Payment certificate will not be treated as credential.
- ii) **Completion Certificate** issued by the Executive Engineer or equivalent competent authority of a State/Central Govt., State/Central Govt. undertaking, Statutory/Autonomous bodies constituted under the Central/State Statute on the executed value of completed/running works will be considered as Credential.
- iii) No credential will be considered as valid unless it is supported by work order, price schedule or BOQ of work and completion certificate mentioning the date of completion issued by the competent authority not below the rank of Executive Engineer or equivalent or competent authority of a State / Central Government, State / Central Government undertakings, Statutory /

Autonomous bodies constituted under the Central / State Statute. The completion certificate should indicate the value of the work (equal to booked expenditure) [Non Statutory Documents].

N.B. Estimated amount, Date of completion of project & detail communicational address of Client must be indicated in the Credential Certificate.

- C) Scanned copy of PAN card, P. Tax, Valid income tax return(For Last 3 yrs), Valid 15 digit Goods and Services Taxpayer Identification Number (GSTIN) under GST Act, 2017 & Latest Valid Trade License, Last 3 yrs audited balance sheet, Credentials, Work Order, Completion Certificate, Payment certificate, Bank Solvency Certificate within one year from the date of publishing of NIT, Registration Certificate and/or trade license of the company must be submitted duly digitally signed at desired location in the website <https://wbtennders.gov.in>.
 - D) Scanned Copy of one affidavit before Notary will have to be submitted mentioning the correctness of the documents and a declaration of penalty debarment etc. faced by him under any Govt./Semi-Govt./Autonomous body/Institution through on line at desired location.
 - E) Partnership Firm/Consortium should submit necessary deed at desired location through on line.
 - F) Particulars regarding Joint Ventures/Consortium.
 - i) The lead partner must have credential and satisfactory completion of similar nature of work of completion cost not less than 50% value of qualifying amount i.e. 50% of the value of work under present tender.
 - ii) Each of the other partners shall meet individually not less than 25% of the qualifying criteria mentioned above under any Govt./Semi-Govt. organization/Autonomous body as principal employer within last 5 (Five) years.
 - iii) The lead partner shall have to apply for tender on behalf of Joint Ventures/Consortium along with MoA/MoU.
 - iv) In case of any litigation or in the event of any default arises during the execution/contract period of the agreement, the lead partner will remain fully responsible.
 - v) The successful Joint Ventures/Consortium will have to submit GSTIN under GST Act, 2017. Pan Card, Trade License immediately after issuance of LOI
 - G) **Earnest Money:-** The tenderer shall have to deposit requisite earnest money along with the tender document in prescribed manner failing which the tender shall be rejected. The balance earnest money if any to fulfill 2(two) percent of the tender value is to be deposited at the time of execution of formal agreement.
- 5) **a) List of common documents shall have to be uploaded by each tenderer at the time of submission of Tender through online:-**

 - a) Work Order along with completion certificate for the work in technical credential.
 - b) Payment certificate of the said work.

- viii) Current Bank Solvency Certificate.
 - ix) Affidavit before Notary mentioning the correctness of the documents and declaration of penalty debarment etc.
 - b) List of documents shall have to upload by a Partnership Firm in addition to Sl. No.5.a)**
 - i) The power of Attorney for the firm for signing the tender by a partner.
 - ii) Partnership Deed.
 - c) List of documents shall have to upload by a Joint Venture/Consortium in addition to Sl. No. 5.a)**
 - i) Copy of MoA/MoU on a stamp paper of Rs.100.00 outlining the joint interest to work on the project and specifying the other terms of agreement.
- 6) The prospective bidders shall have in their full time engagement experienced technical personnel, with the sufficient knowledge of PERT/CPM, the minimum being one Civil Engineering Degree holder and one Civil Engineering Diploma holder (Authenticated documents in respect of qualification and engagement shall be furnished for Technical-Evaluation). [Non Statutory Documents]
 - 7) Neither prospective bidders nor any of constituent partner had been debarred to participate in tender by the KMDA during the last 5 (five) years prior to the date of this NIT. Such debar will be considered as disqualification towards eligibility. (A declaration in this respect has to be furnished by the prospective bidders as per prescribed format without which the Technical Bid shall be treated non-responsive).
 - 8) All materials required for execution of the work (as per BOQ) shall be supplied by the contractor at their own cost including Bitumen (All grade), Cement and Steel also.
 - 9) **Bids shall remain valid** for a period not less than 120 days (One Hundred Twenty) from the last date of submission of Financial Bid / Sealed Bid. If the bidder withdraws the bid during the period of bid validity the earnest money as deposited will be forfeited forthwith without assigning any reason thereof.
 - 10) All materials required for the proposed scheme including bitumen (all grade), bitumen emulsion, cement & steel shall be of specified grade & approved brand in conformity with relevant code of practice (latest revision) & manufacture accordingly and shall be procured & supplied by the agency at their own cost including all taxes. In the event of further testing opted by the Engineer-in-Charge, then such testing from any Government approved Testing Laboratory shall have to be conducted by the agency at their own cost. Only 60/70(VG 30) grade paving bitumen of I.O.C.L/ B.P.C.L/ H.P.C.L (from nearest depot) will be permitted as Straight run Bitumen.
 - 11) **CONDITIONAL and INCOMPLETE TENDER** will not be accepted under any circumstances.
 - 12) The Superintending Engineer, Circle-II, KMDA reserves the right to cancel the N.I.T. due to unavoidable circumstances and no claim in this respect will be entertained.
 - 13) During scrutiny, if it is come to the notice to tender inviting authority that the credential or any other papers found incorrect/manufactured/fabricated, that tenderer will not be allowed to participate in the tender and that application will be out rightly rejected without any prejudice with forfeiture of earnest money forthwith.

List of "Technically Qualified Bidders" will be published in the web portal only. Financial Bid will be opened within a short period after such publication. Therefore Bidders are requested to view the tender status on a regular basis. In case if there be any objection regarding Pre-qualification/ list of "Technically Qualified Bidders", that objection should be lodged to the Chairman, Tender/Bid Evaluation Committee within **24 hours** from the date and time of publication of list of qualified Agency and beyond that time schedule no objection will be entertained by the Tender/Bid Evaluation Committee.

- 14) Before issuance of the LOI, the tender inviting authority may verify the credential & other documents of the lowest tenderer if found necessary. After verification, if it is found that such

documents submitted by the lowest tenderer is either manufacture or false in that case, LOI will not be issued in favour of the tenderer under any circumstances.

15) Language of Tender:- The tender shall be submitted in the prescribed form in English. All literatures and correspondence in connection with the tenders shall be in English.

16) Others: - The Tender Notice along with other documents like **Tender Form No. - 1 KMDA, Technical Specification, Special Terms and Conditions, BOQ, Addendum and corrigendum etc.** whatever documents uploaded by the department concerned thereto shall be part and parcel of the Tender. The agency must go through carefully the Special Terms and Conditions uploaded by the department before quoting his rate.

The tender inviting authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason what so ever.

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
